When I'm at home I often call my friends to just have a little chat with them, I make myself some food (I am not very good at cooking but I'm open to trying new recepies), if I need to I also study or prepare things for the next day of school, if i don't have anything to prepare I like making bracelets, reading or watching something on Netflix. I also really enjoy meeting up with my friends because we all live near each other, we go shopping in the nearest mall, sometimes we go on walks or just chill around at each others houses. In the Evening when my mom's home from work, we eat dinner together and watch our favorite TV show. I go to bed at aroung nine/ten a'clock and wake up again at around six thirtee to go shower and get ready, eat breakfast etc. then I leave the house arond 7:50 am to meet up with a friend of mine. Because we live very close to our school (three minute walk) we are mostly on time. My school starts at 8 am and ends normally at 1:15 pm, except for tuesday and thursday where I have classes until 3:45 pm. During the normal two breaks we have, we mostly walk around and eat something, sometimes we study before an exam but normally it's just a chill break from class. On those long days we have an extra 45 minute break before the late classes, where me and my friends go to have lunch in the school cafeteria. My favorite subjects in school are english, german and theatre so those lessons i am most excited for. I also really enjoy the art lessons because they're more calm compared to other lessons. have a great family, we all live near each other and we celebrate everything together at my grandmas house, for example birthdays, christmas, easter etc. I am very close with my grandma she's like a second mother to me, i visit her every wednesday after school. We eat lunch together, she helps me with school work, we play games together and in the evening we watch our favorite show Gilmore Girls on the TV. She also has a big garden with a trampoline that I use for practicing tumbling tricks and flips. My sister used to also live near us but two years ago she moved to the Netherlands so I don't see her often but we try to visit each other at least twice a year. During the holidays I mostly travel to denmark with my family. We've been going there every summer since I was a baby for 2-4 weeks and sometimes also in spring or fall. We stay on a little island with only around 12 inhabitants wich is very idyllic and a great distraction from all of the big town noise, lights etc. And there also live many animals like dogs, cows, horses and cats that I like to pet or just simply be around. Something that is different fom England, Spain or USA, not too close but also not too far away from home so that I have the opportunity to go there again after my exchange year, and then i found the Sweden program and it was everything I had wished for. I think that I'm gonna be a great exchange student because I love getting to know new traditions, trying new food, expierencing a different school system and mostly obviously I am so excited to meet new people from a different country. And I also think that I would be a good exchange student because I'm not that compicated. I can do the dishes, I can do laundry(if you tell me how the washing machine works), i can clean my room, I can help with cooking or grocery shopping and I will follow the rules you set for me! Also what I'm very excited for is you(my host family) teaching me things about sweden like traditional food, I would love to bake or cook with you, to learn about your culture and your life in sweden and how it may be different compared to my life in Germany or mabye we even realize similarities between Germany and Sweden.
